

Are you ready for registration day?

The Red Cross swimming program has been discontinued and swimming lessons will now be offered through the Lifesaving Society. ***It is strongly encouraged before registration opens, to determine the last level your child completed in Red Cross.*** Transition charts are available online at <https://boissevain.ca/recreation/pool/>

Swimming lesson registration has been online through Booking (now Univerus) for several years. If you have registered for swimming lessons in the past couple years, you will already have an online account.

Follow these step-by-step instructions to login to your account, and find previous courses.

1. Go to website to login to your account:






2. After you login in, click on **“Go to My Account”**
