RE: BOIL WATER ADVISORY ISSUED TO A PORTION OF THE BOISSEVAIN WATER SYSTEM

Drinking Water Officer, Nancy Fitzgerald has advised me that the Boissevain water system has met all conditions for rescinding the boil water advisory and that bacteriological testing results meet regulatory standards.

I am therefore rescinding the boil water advisory that was placed on a portion of the Boissevain distribution system [Buckingham Street between Stephen Street and McKenzie Street, Boissevain School, 793 Mill Road, 794 McKenzie Street, 784 McKenzie Street, 100 William Street, and the Busy B Drive Inn] on May 9, 2023.

Please ensure all water users are notified that the advisory has been rescinded and that normal water usage can be resumed. A copy of this letter can be provided as notification. Notices posted in public locations are to be removed.
